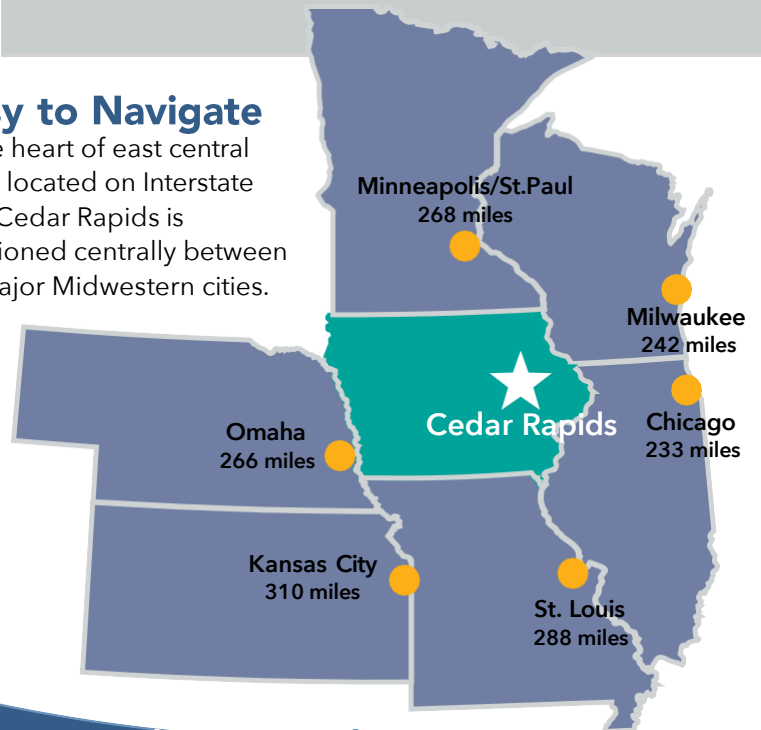
Over \$1.5 billion in downtown revitalization

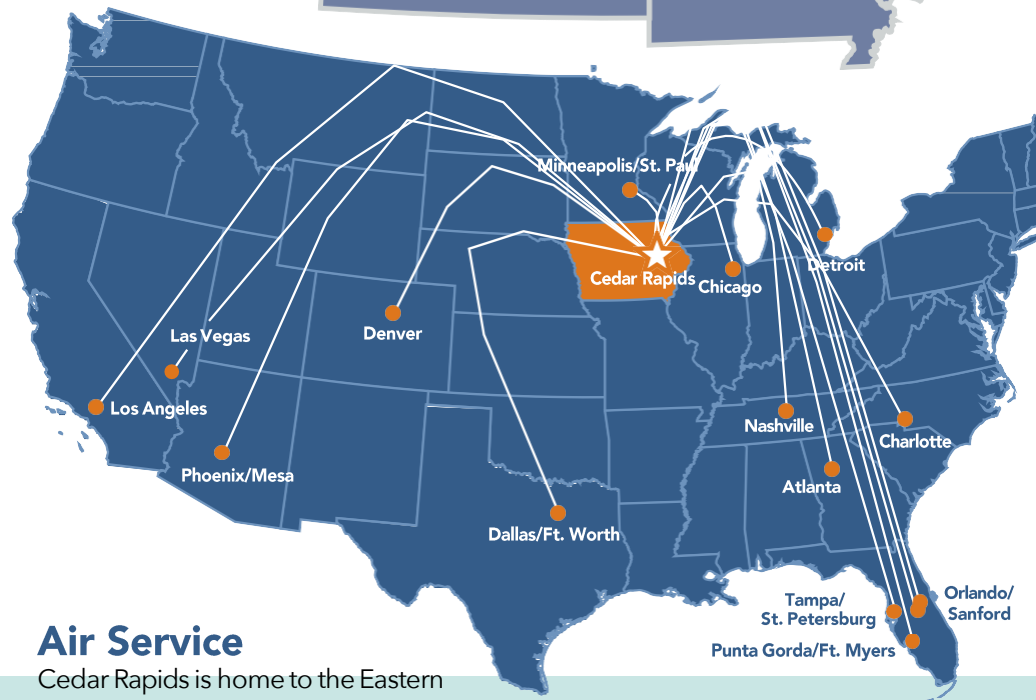
Easy to Navigate

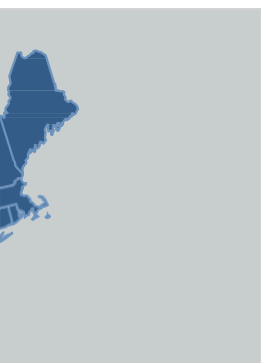

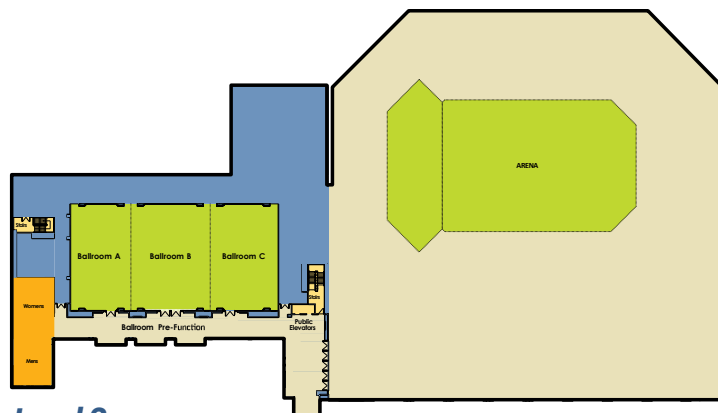
